

Who are We?

Parentant offers services to facilitate parental access rights, by providing a healthy, safe and conflict-free environment in which children and parents can meet. As a community organization, we are here for all Brome-Missisquoi & Haute-Yamaska parents who feel they are in need of our services.

Our Mandate

1. To promote the wellbeing of children who are going through a period of separation from a parent, while supporting the parent-child relationship, in a healthy, safe, and conflict-free environment.
2. To prevent and alleviate distress in families
3. To help maintain and develop the parent-child bond.

Our Objectives

1. To offer a welcoming environment, and a safe and neutral space in which situations of conflict can be addressed and resolved satisfactorily, protecting children from becoming involved in such conflicts.
2. To allow non-custodial parents to exercise their rights of access.
3. To create a pleasant and well-planned time for parent and child to meet, in the care of qualified personnel.

Our Clientele

Parents

We seek to provide services for parents who, following a Court judgment or any other non-judicial reason (misunderstanding, fear, etc), must or would like to use a supervised visitation or custody exchange service to help them to exercise their right to access their child. What is important for parents to remember is that we are here for you, so don't hesitate to contact us!

Children

- Any child who is the object of voluntary or judicial measures under Youth Protection law which specify supervised visits.
- Any child whose parents are under an order of the Superior Court which specifies supervised visits or a neutral location in which custody transfers must take place
- Any child referred by a lawyer following an agreement reached between parties involved in separation proceedings, when supervised meetings or a neutral location for transfer of custody has been recommended
- Any child whose two (2) parents wish to make use of the services we offer

Our Services

Supervised visits

Period of time shared by parent and child under the supervision of a third person. Le Parentant allows parents to maintain contact with their children in an environment which is safe for their children. As an additional service, it is possible for us to accompany parents and children on supervised outings, when permitted by the custodial judgment. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Supervised Custodial Exchanges

This service offers a safe space for the child to make the transition between the custodial parent and the parent exercising access rights, without requiring any contact between parents.

Process for Requesting Services

- The request for services must be made by a lawyer, an organisation, by professionals in the Youth Protection service, or by both parents.
- The parent or parents using the service must sign an agreement, in which he, she or they agree to respect the rules of the service.
- A copy of the Court judgment or the agreement between parents must be provided in order to complete the file of the parent using the service.

**Are There Fees
for the Service?**

Supervised Visits:

- One-time fee to open a file: \$10
- \$4 per visit

Supervised Custody Exchanges:

- One-time fee to open a file: \$10
(\$5 per parent)
- \$2 per parent per exchange

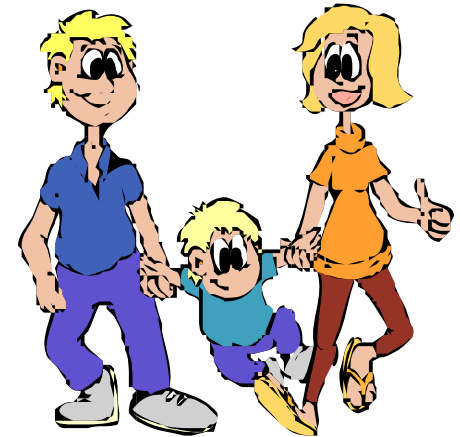
